Job Content

The Product Specialist has three primary focus areas:

- 1) Enabling new and existing partners.
You will be a ForNAV evangelist, ensuring knowledge transfer and onboarding our partner channel. You should make our partners successful with their first ForNAV projects, and maintain a high level of interest and enthusiasm around our products. As we have partners all over the world, most of this will happen through online meetings.
- 2) Assisting our development team.
This can include reviewing features, testing new versions, providing input on product news and updates, and other tasks.
- 3) Support.
Helping our support function assist partners with general questions and specific projects.

The role can be full-time or part-time, as per agreement.

Apart from speaking and writing fluent Danish, this role also requires very strong skills in speaking and writing English.

As we are a young company, a high degree of flexibility is required. The role will primarily take place in the ForNAV office north of Copenhagen. However, limited travel should be expected, primarily to join events and visit partners. We estimate this to be a maximum of 20-25 days per year.

You will work with a small group of highly skilled people, focusing on creating world-class tools for reporting. With the right attitude, you can expect to develop personally and professionally. You will gain strong skills in cloud computing and we will help you learn relevant tools, such as JavaScript, if you're not familiar with them already.

Your skills and background

Most importantly, you know Microsoft Dynamics NAV. You have a good understanding of the application and the data model. You are able to do some programming in C/AL without being a full-time developer. In particular, you have experience with creating and maintaining reports. If you know the C/SIDE reporting tool, it is an advantage.

You might have worked in an internal or support function for some time, and are now ready to move on to something more external. Whether you work with an NAV customer, a partner, or in a freelance capacity is not so important.

You are a team player, service minded, able to work in an agile and sometimes a bit unstructured organization, and you have a good sense of humor.
